Terms of Service - Integrations

Definitions

1. In this Contract:

“**Contract**” means these, these terms and conditions, and the Terms of Service.

“**IPR**” means all present and future rights, title and interest to intellectual property including any inventions and improvements, trademarks (whether registered or common law trade marks), designs, copyright, any corresponding property rights under the laws of any jurisdiction and any rights in respect of an invention, discovery, trade secret, secret process, know-how, concept, idea, information, process, data, or formula.

“**Institution**” means the school or other institution named in the Integration Licence.

“**Integration Licence**” means the licence granted to the Institution by Licensor in respect of the Software.

“**Licensor**” means Computing Directions Australia trading as Synergetic Management Systems (ACN 052 442 896).

“**MyEdOnline**” means myEdOnline Pty Ltd ACN 156 213 133 ABN 16 156 213 133.

“**Software**” means the myEdOnline Teaching & Learning platform.

“**Terms of Service**” means the attached Terms of Service as Attachment 1, as varied by myEdOnline from time to time by written notice to the Institution.

Acknowledgement of Terms

2. The Institution acknowledges that:

- A. the Software is of importance and value to the myEdOnline;
- B. all IPR (whether registered or not) in and to the Software is owned absolutely by, and vests absolutely in, myEdOnline;
- C. except for the rights granted by these Contract and the Integration Licence, the Institution does not have IPR (whether

registered or not) in or to the Software;

- D. the Institution has received the Terms of Service attached and agrees to the Terms of Service on its own capacity and for and on behalf of each employee, agent or contractor of it;
- E. the Integration Licence applies to the extent of any inconsistency between this Contract and the Integration Licence;
- F. the myEdOnline API will be activated which will allow some information to flow between Licensor and myEdOnline to facilitate the use of e-learning. This information will include personal information of users of the e-learning service, which will be held in accordance with the Terms of Service; and
- G. if the Institution has an agreement with myEdOnline for the use of the Software other than under this Integration Licence (including in relation to any additional functions) (**Separate myEdOnline Agreement**), then the Separate myEdOnline Agreement will apply to the use of such parts of the Software and the Separate myEdOnline Agreement will continue to apply if this Contract is terminated.

Prohibited Use

3. The Institution will be considered to have breached an essential term of this Contract by engaging in the following conduct in relation to the Software:
 - A. copying, reproducing, translating, adapting, varying, merging, modifying or creating any derivative work based on the Software;
 - B. reverse engineering, decompiling, disassembling, reconfiguring or otherwise attempting to ascertain the source code of the Software; and
 - C. selling, marketing, networking, transferring, leasing, licensing, renting, lending or otherwise assigning of or distributing the Software.

Attachment 1 - Terms of Service

The following are the terms of service (“Terms of Service”) that define the relationship between myEdOnline Pty Ltd (doing business as myEdOnline App [“Company,” “myEdOnline,” “we,” or “us”]) and you, and govern your use of myEdOnline’s services.

We’ve done our best to write this policy in simple, clear terms. We’ve also added a summary paragraph at the beginning of each section that provides a short explanation of the legal language in plain English (it starts with ‘Basically...’) to help you understand our terms, but it isn’t legally binding.

Agreeing to our Terms

Basically, by using or signing up for myEdOnline, you agree to these terms, Welcome to the myEdOnline Community.

You can use myEdOnline as long as you follow the rules in these terms.

When using the Service, you will also be subject to the [myEdOnline Privacy Policy](#) and any posted guidelines, policies or rules applicable to specific features of the myEdOnline Site or myEdOnline App, which may be posted from time to time (collectively the “Guidelines”). These Terms of Service, including any other Guidelines and future modifications (collectively, the “Agreement”) govern your use of the Service and is a legal contract between you and myEdOnline. By registering for an account on, or otherwise accessing or using the myEdOnline Service, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to be bound by this Agreement. If you are using the Service on behalf of an institution that has a separate written agreement with myEdOnline, that agreement governs your use of the Service.

To keep up with the dynamic needs of teachers and learners everywhere our Service is constantly changing – so, these Terms might need to change, too. If they do change, we will do our best to tell you in advance by placing a notification on the myEdOnlineapp.com website, or we might send you an email.

If you don’t like the new Terms, you are free to reject them – unfortunately, that means you won’t be able to use the Service anymore. If you use the Service in any way after a change to the Terms is effective, then please remember that means you agree to all of the Terms.

If you are entering into this Agreement on behalf of a company or other legal entity, you represent that you have the authority to bind such entity to these terms and conditions, in which case the terms “you”, “your” or “Member” shall refer to such entity. If you do not have such authority, or if you do not agree with these terms and conditions, you must not accept this Agreement and may not use the Service.

Privacy

Basically, your privacy is extremely important to us. Have a read of our [Privacy Policy](#) which explains how we treat and protect any personal information you may provide us.

Your privacy is extremely important to us, and we take great care to limit what we collect and how we use it, and to enable you to understand our policies. Please read our [Privacy Policy](#) which explains how we treat your personal information and protect your privacy when you

Intellectual Property

Basically, your intellectual property rights are very important to us. You (or your employer) own any content you post on myEdOnline – we don't claim any ownership rights in any content you submit to myEdOnline.

You do however give us permission to use it to provide the myEdOnline service to you and other users. Our use of any personal information you submit is also subject to our [Privacy Policy](#).

The Content

The materials displayed or performed on the Service (including, but not limited to, text, graphics, articles, photos, images, illustrations, User Submissions (defined below), and so forth) (the "Content") are protected by copyright and other intellectual property laws.

(such as changes we make so that your content works better with our Service) such User Submissions as necessary to provide, improve and make the Service available to you and other users, including through any future media in which the Service may be distributed, (ii) use and disclose metrics and analytics regarding the User Submissions in an aggregate or other non-personally identifiable manner (including, for use in improving our service or in marketing and business development purposes), (iii) use any User Submission (including any Education Record) that has been de-identified for any product development, research or other purpose; and (iv) use for other purposes permitted by the [myEdOnline Privacy Policy](#).

This is a license only – your ownership in User Submissions is not affected.

Personal User Submissions

If you store a User Submission in your own personal myEdOnline account, in a manner that is not viewable by any other user except you (a “Personal User Submission”), you grant myEdOnline the license above, as well as a license to display, perform, and distribute your Personal User Submission for the sole purpose of displaying that Personal User Submission to you and provide you the Service necessary to do so.

Sharing User Submissions – Limited Access Group

If you share a User Submission only within a Limited Access Group, or otherwise in a manner that only certain specified users can view (for example, a class or within an organisation) (each, a “Limited Access User Submission”), then you grant myEdOnline the license above, as well as a license to display, perform, and distribute your Limited Access User Submission for the sole purpose of displaying that Limited Access User Submission to other members of that Limited Access Group (or to such specified users, as applicable) and providing you the Service necessary to do so. Finally, you understand and agree that myEdOnline, in performing the required technical steps to provide the Service to our users (including you), may need to make changes to your User Submissions to conform and adapt those User Submissions to the technical requirements of connection networks, devices (i.e tablets & smartphones), services, or media.

Who is responsible for what I see and do on myEdOnline?

Basically, you are responsible for any information or content you share on myEdOnline and you access all such information at your own risk.

This means when you share content on myEdOnline you need to consider who owns the intellectual property in the content and whether you have the rights to share this content and with whom you can share it with. This may be governed by any employment agreement you have with your organisation.

Any information or content publicly posted or privately transmitted through the Service is the sole responsibility of the person from whom such content originated, and you access all such information and content at your own risk, and we aren't liable for any errors or omissions in that information or content or for any damages or loss you might suffer in connection with it.

We cannot control and have no duty to take any action regarding how you may interpret and use the Content or what actions you may take as a result of having been exposed to the Content, and you hereby release us from all liability for you having acquired or not acquired Content through the Services.

The Services may contain, or direct you to websites containing, information you may find offensive or inappropriate; we can't control that, but please let us know if it happens and we'll try to remedy the situation.

We also can't guarantee the identity of any users with whom you interact in using the Services and are not responsible for which users gain access to the Services. But that doesn't mean we don't take security seriously; students are only permitted to access the Service within their Limited Access Groups, we require teachers, schools, and districts guard their Access Codes with the appropriate confidentiality, as described in the Acceptable Use Policy below, we enable teachers with moderation tools for monitoring content within Limited Access Groups, and student accounts are not enabled to "browse" groups to join (a student is only permitted to view and join a group he or she has been given an Access Code to).

You are responsible for all Content you contribute, in any manner, to the Service, and you represent and warrant you have all rights necessary to do so, in the manner in which you contribute it. Please note that your intellectual property rights may be governed by any employment agreement you may have with an organisation. You will keep all your registration information accurate and current. You are responsible for all your activity in connection with the Service.

Your Warranty

Basically, you agree not to post content that harms others or violates anyone's rights. We believe you'll be reasonable and responsible, but if you're not we might have to remove your content.

You warrant, represent and agree that you will not provide any User Submissions or otherwise use the Service in a manner that (i) infringes, violates or misappropriates another's intellectual property rights, rights of publicity or privacy, or other rights; (ii) violates any international, federal, state or local law, statute, ordinance or regulation or which would render Company in violation of any applicable laws or regulations (iii) is harmful, fraudulent, threatening, abusive, harassing, tortuous, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, libelous, or otherwise objectionable; or (iv) jeopardizes the security of your account in any way, such as allowing someone else access to your account or password. Additionally, you represent, warrant and agree that you possess all rights necessary to provide your User Submissions and grant Company the rights above.

Acceptable Use Policy

Basically, you agree not to misuse myEdOnline's services. If you do misuse myEdOnline we may have to terminate your access to use the Service.

We do our best to keep myEdOnline safe, but we cannot guarantee it. We need your help to keep myEdOnline safe, which includes the following commitments by you when using our Service:

- You will only use the Service as permitted by law, including applicable export or re-export control laws and regulations.
- You will not post unauthorized commercial communications (such as spam or advertisements) on or through the Service.

If you are a student, please do not provide any personal information about yourself to us, other than what we request from you when you are able to sign up for the Service.

Additional Terms by User Type – Teachers

Basically, if you are a teacher and want to create and use a myEdOnline account please be sure your school, district or educational organisation is fine with you using myEdOnline.

Teachers: if you are a teacher, aide, or other similar personnel accessing the Service on behalf of a school, school district, or other similar educational organisation (the “Organisation”), the following terms apply to you:

Termination

If a dispute arises out of or relates to this agreement, or the breach, termination, validity or subject matter thereof, or as to any related claim in restitution or at law in equity or pursuant to any statute, the parties to the agreement and the dispute expressly agree to endeavour to settle the dispute by mediation administered by the Australian Commercial Disputes Centre (ACDC) before having recourse to arbitration or litigation.

The mediation shall be conducted in accordance with the ACDC Guidelines for Commercial Mediation which are operating at the time the matter is referred to ACDC.

The Guidelines set out the procedures to be adopted, the process of selection of the mediator and the costs involved. The terms of the Guidelines are hereby deemed incorporated into this agreement.

Notwithstanding the foregoing obligation to arbitrate disputes, each party shall have the right to pursue injunctive or other equitable relief at any time, from any court of competent jurisdiction.

For all purposes of this Agreement, the parties consent to exclusive jurisdiction and venue in the state of New South Wales, Australia.

Miscellaneous

Basically, failure to exercise a right under this agreement does not mean we've waived the right. If any part of this agreement is not valid, the rest will remain in force. This agreement represents the complete agreement between you and us.

You will be responsible for withholding, filing, and reporting all taxes, duties, and other governmental assessments associated with your activity in connection with the Services.

The failure of either you or us to exercise, in any way, any right herein shall not be deemed a waiver of any further rights hereunder. If any provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that provision will be limited or eliminated, to the minimum extent necessary, so that these Terms shall otherwise remain in full force and effect and enforceable.

You and myEdOnline agree that these Terms are the complete and exclusive statement of the mutual understanding between you and myEdOnline, and that it supersedes and cancels all previous written and oral agreements, communications, and other understandings relating to the subject matter of these Terms, and that all modifications to these Terms must be in a writing signed by both parties (except as otherwise provided herein).

No agency, partnership, joint venture, or employment is created as a result of these Terms and you do not have any authority of any kind to bind myEdOnline in any respect whatsoever. You and myEdOnline agree there are no third party beneficiaries intended under this Agreement.
